BackGround:

PP2C κ (protein phosphatase 2C isoform κ), also known as PP2C-type mitochondrial phosphoprotein phosphatase and PP2C domain-containing protein phosphatase 1K, is a 372 amino acid mitochondrial matrix protein that regulates the opening of mitochondrial membrane permeability transition pores. PP2C κ is essential for cell survival, cardiac function and embryonic development. Knock-down of PP2C κ results in cell death due to loss of mitochondrial membrane potential. PP2C κ specifically binds to the branched-chain- α ketoacid dehydrogenase (BCKD) complex and induces dephosphorylation of Ser293, effectively leading to the inhibition of branched chain amino acid metabolism. Highest expression of PP2C κ is found in brain, diaphragm and heart. There are three isoforms of PP2C κ that are produced as a result of alternative splicing events.

WB:1:500~1:1000 IHC:1:50~1:200

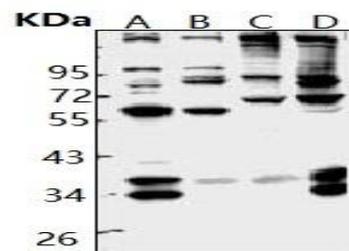
Storage&Stability:

Store at 4 °C short term. Aliquot and store at -25 °C long term. Avoid freeze-thaw cycles.
