3-hydroxyisobutyrate dehydrogenase(HIBADH) Homo sapiens This gene encodes a mitochondrial 3-hydroxyisobutyrate dehydrogenase enzyme. The encoded protein plays a critical role in the catabolism of L-valine by catalyzing the oxidation of 3-hydroxyisobutyrate to methylmalonate semialdehyde. [provided by RefSeq, Nov 2011],

**Applications:**


Immunohistochemistry: 1/100 - 1/300. ELISA: 1/10000. Not yet tested in other applications.

**Storage&Stability:**

Store at 4 °C short term. Aliquot and store at -20 °C long term. Avoid freeze-thaw cycles.

**Specificity:**

HIBADH Polyclonal Antibody detects endogenous levels of HIBADH protein.

**DATA:**

Immunohistochemistry analysis of paraffin-embedded human breast carcinoma tissue, using HIBADH Antibody. The picture on the right is blocked with the synthesized peptide.
