BackGround:

microtubule associated protein tau(MAPT) Homo sapiens
This gene encodes the microtubule-associated protein tau (MAPT) whose transcript undergoes complex, regulated alternative splicing, giving rise to several mRNA species. MAPT transcripts are differentially expressed in the nervous system, depending on stage of neuronal maturation and neuron type. MAPT gene mutations have been associated with several neurodegenerative disorders such as Alzheimer's disease, Pick's disease, frontotemporal dementia, cortico-basal degeneration and progressive supranuclear palsy. Product:

Liquid in PBS containing 50% glycerol, 0.5% BSA and 0.02% sodium azide.

Molecular Weight:

~50-85kDa

Purification&Purity:

The antibody was affinity-purified from rabbit antiserum by affinity-chromatography using epitope-specific im-

munogen.

Applications:

Western Blot: 1/500 - 1/2000. Immunohistochemistry: 1/100 - 1/300. ELISA: 1/5000. Not yet tested in other applications.

Storage&Stability:

Store at 4 °C short term. Aliquot and store at -20 °C long term. Avoid freeze-thaw cycles.

Specificity:

Phospho-Tau (T534) Polyclonal Antibody detects endogenous levels of Tau protein only when phosphorylated at T534.

DATA:

Western blot analysis of lysates from rat brain, using Tau (Phospho-Thr534/217) Antibody. The lane on the right is blocked with the phospho peptide.
