

**GNRH1 polyclonal antibody**

BackGround:

This gene encodes a preproprotein that is proteolytically processed to generate a peptide that is a member of the gonadotropin-releasing hormone (GnRH) family of peptides. Alternative splicing results in multiple transcript variants, at least one of which is secreted and then cleaved to generate gonadoliberein-1 and GnRH-associated peptide 1. Gonadoliberein-1 stimulates the release of luteinizing and follicle stimulating hormones, which are important for reproduction. Mutations in this gene are associated with hypogonadotropic hypogonadism.

1mg/ml in PBS with 0.02% sodium azide, 50% glycerol, pH7.2

Purification&Purity:

The antibody was affinity-purified from rabbit antiserum by affinity-chromatography using epitope-specific immunogen and the purity is > 95% (by SDS-PAGE).

WB, 1:500 - 1:2000 | IF/ICC, 1:50 - 1:200

Storage&Stability:

Store at 4 °C short term. Aliquot and store at -20 °C long term. Avoid freeze-thaw cycles.

DATA:

Western blot analysis of extracts of Mouse lung, using GNRH1 antibody at 1:1000 dilution. Secondary antibody: HRP Goat Anti-Rabbit IgG at 1:10000 dilution. Lysates/proteins: 25ug per lane. Blocking buffer: 3% nonfat dry milk in TBST. Detection: ECL Basic Kit. Exposure time: 180s.

Western blot analysis of extracts of Rat kidney, using GNRH1 antibody at 1:1000 dilution. Secondary antibody: HRP Goat Anti-Rabbit IgG at 1:10000 dilution. Lysates/proteins: 25ug per lane. Blocking buffer: 3% nonfat dry milk in TBST. Detection: ECL Enhanced Kit. Exposure time: 60s.

Immunofluorescence analysis of SH-SY5Y cells using GNRH1 Rabbit pAb at dilution of 1:200. Blue: DAPI for nuclear staining.

Immunofluorescence analysis of NIH/3T3 cells using GNRH1 Rabbit pAb at dilution of 1:50. Blue: DAPI for nuclear staining.
