

FAF2 polyclonal antibody

Background:

The protein encoded by this gene is highly expressed in peripheral blood of patients with atopic dermatitis (AD), compared to normal individuals. It may play a role in regulating the resistance to apoptosis that is observed in T cells and eosinophils of AD patients.

1mg/ml in PBS with 0.02% sodium azide, 50% glycerol, pH7.2

Purification&Purity:

The antibody was affinity-purified from rabbit antiserum by affinity-chromatography using epitope-specific immunogen and the purity is > 95% (by SDS-PAGE).



Storage&Stability:


Store at 4 °C short term. Aliquot and store at -20 °C long term. Avoid freeze-thaw cycles.

DATA:

Western blot analysis of extracts of various cell lines, using FAF2 antibody at 1:1000 dilution. Secondary antibody: HRP Goat Anti-Rabbit IgG at 1:10000 dilution. Lysates/proteins: 25ug per lane. Blocking buffer: 3% nonfat dry milk in TBST. Detection: ECL Basic Kit. Exposure time: 1s.
