

ERCC4 polyclonal antibody

BackGround:

The protein encoded by this gene forms a complex with ERCC1 and is involved in the 5' incision made during nucleotide excision repair. This complex is a structure specific DNA repair endonuclease that interacts with EME1. Defects in this gene are a cause of xeroderma pigmentosum complementation group F (XP-F), or xeroderma pigmentosum VI (XP6).

Purification&Purity:

The antibody was affinity-purified from rabbit antiserum by affinity-chromatography using epitope-specific immunogen and the purity is > 95% (by SDS-PAGE).



Storage&Stability:


Store at 4 °C short term. Aliquot and store at -20 °C long term. Avoid freeze-thaw cycles.

DATA:

Western blot analysis of extracts of various cell lines, using ERCC4 antibody at 1:1000 dilution. Secondary antibody: HRP Goat Anti-Rabbit IgG at 1:10000 dilution. Lysates/proteins: 25ug per lane. Blocking buffer: 3% nonfat dry milk in TBST. Detection: ECL Basic Kit. Exposure time: 30s.



Immunoprecipitation analysis of 150ug extracts of 293T cells using 3ug ERCC4 antibody. Western blot was performed from the immunoprecipitate using ERCC4 antibody at a dilution of 1:1000.
