

KRT10 monoclonal antibody

BackGround:

This gene encodes a member of the type I (acidic) cyto-keratin family, which belongs to the superfamily of intermediate filament (IF) proteins. Keratins are hetero-polymeric structural proteins which form the intermediate filament. These filaments, along with actin microfila-ments and microtubules, compose the cytoskeleton of ep-ithelial cells. Mutations in this gene are associated with epidermolytic hyperkeratosis. This gene is located within a cluster of keratin family members on chromosome 17q21.

The antibody was affinity-purified from mouse ascites by affinity-chromatography using epitope-specific immuno-gen and the purity is > 95% (by SDS-PAGE).

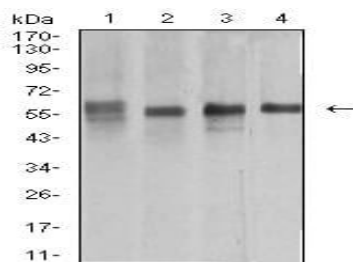
Storage&Stability:

Store at 4 °C short term. Aliquot and store at -20 °C long term. Avoid freeze-thaw cycles.

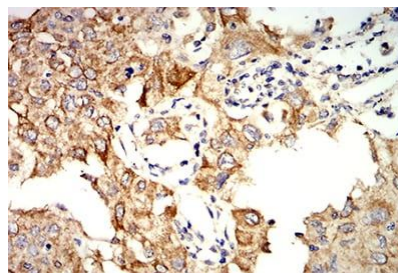
